- Implement the “Werribee Way” Club Curriculum.

### **Selection Criteria (essential):**

- Hold current with Working with Children Check (WWCC) & be willing to sign the VJBL Statutory Declaration and Coaches Conduct form; &
- Hold a current Club (Level 1) coaching accreditation prior to the commencement of the 2019/20 VJBL season OR be willing to obtain prior to commencement of the 2019/20 VJBL season.

### **Selection Criteria (desired):**

- Previous coaching experience;
- Playing experience; &
- Other relevant qualifications e.g. teaching, sports management etc.
