



## GLORY LEAGUE POLICY APRIL 2026

### POLICY STATEMENT

The Wyndham Basketball Association (WBA) Constitution gives the Executive the responsibility for the control and management of the affairs related to basketball. The Executive, through this policy, outlines the delegations and responsibilities passed onto staff, Executive members and Sub-committees for them to effectively fulfil their duties in an efficient and empowering manner, enabling them to act with clarity and certainty concerning their scope and operation.

### BACKGROUND

This policy statement covers all Executive members, members of the association, staff and its agents. It covers all volunteers (paid or otherwise), players, coaches, spectators, referees, supervisors and all members associated with Wyndham Basketball Association.

### OVERVIEW OF GLORY LEAGUE

Glory League is a world's first automated video system for everyday basketball that allows players to relive their games through professional quality full-game video, highlight reels and stats which is automatically captured using the platforms software and cameras.

A player or coach registered into a participating club or association, will be automatically enrolled in the Glory League system by your club or association.

Glory League takes player privacy seriously, this means that only players, coaches, team staff and club delegates that have registered with their association have access to the game videos, and only for the games that your teams play. Participants must add their family members as supporters themselves using the Glory League Player Portal.

First time participants using Glory League will receive an email from Glory League with their account details after they participate in their first game of the season. The participant will receive a welcome email with a link to set up their account and a notification email when their game video is ready to view.

The "Welcome to Glory League" email and games will be sent to the email address used when registering the participant through the competition management software (PlayHQ). Without a registered email address, the account will not be activated, and hence the participant will not receive game video email notifications.

Participants who have concerns around legal matters (i.e. shared custody, Intervention Order, etc.) and privacy issues, need to contact Glory League directly via [privacy@gloryleague.com](mailto:privacy@gloryleague.com) Glory League will assist the participant with the next steps.

### WBA TERMS & CONDITIONS

All participants, registering into the WBA PlayHQ database, are required to agree to the following terms and conditions at the time of registration. An example of the terms and conditions are below;

- All participants agree to participate under the Wyndham Basketball Association, WBA Constitution and WBA Competition Bylaws, and any other policies adopted by the WBA available on <https://wyndhambasketball.com/policies/>
- As an affiliated member of Basketball Victoria, BV, all members must abide by BV's Codes of Conduct. Breaches of these codes can result in disciplinary action sanctioned under BV Tribunal By-laws. Furthermore, all participants agree to the conditions of entry for all venues operating WBA competitions, programs, activities and events conducted by WBA, including policies relating to the use of CCTV and recording devices.



- By accepting these terms, you acknowledge and agree that we contract Glory League to film your gameplay at Eagle Stadium. You acknowledge and agree that Glory League may use your personal information in the manner and for the purposes set out in Glory League's privacy notice at <https://www.gloryleague.basketball/privacy>

## FOOTAGE ACCESS

Only participants in a game, meaning the players, coach, referees and supporters approved by your association along with Association Administrators have access to view that game video. No participant (i.e. other players, coaches etc.) outside of the team will have access to the footage.

However, the following type of groups may request access to the Video from the WBA Executive or WBA General Manager.

- Basketball Victoria (BV) Tribunal – to review a charge or matter being/to be heard
- WBA Technical Officials – to identify clearly the incident to assisting in the write up an accurate report for the tribunal
- WBA Domestic Club President or Secretary -Still images may be taken from the video to help identify someone from their club
- BV Child Safety Officer – In order to determine whether a matter should be referred to BV Child Safety
- WBA Welfare Officer – In order to determine whether a matter should be referred to BV Child Safety, the WBA Executive or a club executive.
- Western Leisure Services (WLS) – in case the matter involves either damage to facilities or an incident involving facility staff.
- Victorian Police or authorised government agency (e.g. Child Services)

At all times Wyndham Basketball will adhere to any lawful instructions or requests from Victorian police. Where the recordings are handed to the police, after verification of criminal charges the WBA shall delete the information handed to police as it then possibly becomes a criminal matter and subject to criminal proceedings and rules of evidence.

## FOOTAGE STORAGE

Glory League stores personal information on our database hosted on AWS. AWS supports 143 security standards and compliance certifications, including PCI-DSS, HIPAA/HITECH, FedRAMP, GDPR, FIPS 140-2, and NIST 800-171, helping customers satisfy compliance requirements around the globe.

## COMPETITION MATTERS

1. **Individual Statistics.** Glory League will not be used to review or amend individual player statistics.
2. **Game Results**
  - Disputes regarding game results may be submitted for review.
  - Such disputes must be lodged within 24 hours of the game's conclusion via email to [info@wyndhambasketball.com](mailto:info@wyndhambasketball.com)
  - Teams filing a dispute must specify the exact point in the footage where the discrepancy occurred within 24 hours of Glory League releasing the footage. General claims like "The score was wrong" without specific timestamps will not be considered. If the Glory League footage is not released at the time of sending the email, the details will need to be sent to [info@wyndhambasketball.com](mailto:info@wyndhambasketball.com)



3. **Referee/s Judgement Decision.** Glory League footage will not be used to overturn or challenge the judgement decisions made by game officials.
4. **Tribunal & Complaints/Grievances Proceeding.** Footage from Glory League may be utilised during tribunal hearings and to review any footage relating to Complaints/Grievances.
5. **Uniforms and Late Starts.** Glory League will not use to review or impose penalties related to uniforms or late game starts.
6. **Player Eligibility for Finals.** Glory League may be employed to verify player eligibility for finals matches.
7. **Breaches of By-Laws.** Any alleged breaches of by-laws may be investigated using Glory League footage.
8. **Behaviour of Participants and Spectators.** The platform will be used to monitor and review the behaviour of both participants and spectators to ensure compliance with WBA and Basketball Victorias Codes of Conduct.

#### **PRIVACY AND SECURITY**

WBA are committed to protecting the privacy and security of all individuals captured in Glory League footage. Access to game videos is restricted to registered players, coaches, team staff, and club delegates associated with the specific games.
